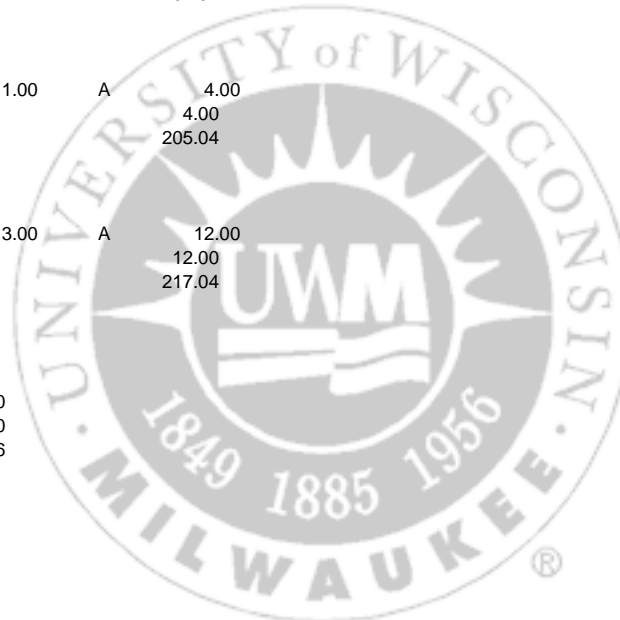

RECORD OF UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN COURSEWORK PRIOR TO JANUARY, 1972

The UWM Graduate School was formed in 1956 as part of The Graduate School of the University of Wisconsin-Madison. Graduate programs were continued as part of The Graduate School as UWMadison until September, 1965, at which time a separate UWM Graduate School was established by action of the University of Wisconsin Regents.

Through the Fall Semester, 1971-72, the policy of the University of Wisconsin System was to maintain one academic record card for each student. If a student attended more than one campus within the University of Wisconsin System, the coursework from all campuses was recorded on one record card. Therefore, if this transcript contains academic work prior to Semester 2-71-72 from UWMadison, UW-Green Bay, UW-Parkside, the UW-Centers or UWExtension, it is the official transcript of that coursework. Beginning with Semester 2-71-72, each campus maintains a separate record card for each student.
