Completion certificates or college credits must be submitted to Educator Licensing &amp; Teacher Quality with the renewal form. The credits must have been earned during the five-year period immediately preceding the renewal.</p> <p>Renewal of license(s) will require completion of 125 clock hours verified by a Minnesota local continuing education committee. If you have been or are currently employed by a Minnesota school district, please contact the district's local continuing education committee.</p> <p>If you do not live in Minnesota and have never been employed in Minnesota, you may renew your license by submitting an official transcript verifying 12 quarter or 8 semester credits in the licensure area(s) or in general education courses.
